
Ladies and Gentlemen,

We cordially invite you to this year's 12th International Scientific Conference from the series of "On the borderlands of cultures and nations". History, culture, dialogue, which will take place in a hybrid form on September 12-14, 2024 at the Jan Grodeck State University in Sanok. The meeting place is not accidental. Sanok and the Land of Sanok are a typical border area where, over the centuries, the influence of many cultures and influences of Polish, Russian, German and Jewish elements have accumulated.

The aim of the Organizers is to present the complexity of borderland issues understood not only in spatial and ethnic terms, but also as a meeting place for different communities, socially, religiously and culturally diverse, with their mutual influence.

As in previous editions, we invite researchers of various specialties from research centers in Poland and abroad to meet and engage in scientific dialogue, contributing a wide range of presentations of problems in historical and contemporary dimensions, in many aspects - sociological, economic, cultural, religious and educational ones.

We invite you to submit proposals for papers on the thematic categories indicated below:

- Multicultural society: social and cultural relations on the borderlands, at the meeting point of ethnoses, religions, cultures, nations, diffusion of cultures on the borderlands;
- Changes in secular and religious, annual and family customs; "own" and "foreign" customs - continuity and change;
- Cultivating one's own (national or regional) cultural tradition and external influences;
- Beliefs (religions), Churches and their relations on the border; church structures in the borderlands;
- Sacred art on the border: preserving one's own artistic (style) tradition and the influence of other ("foreign") artistic patterns;
- Artistic heritage on the borders (troublesome, fragmented, pluralistic, common or categorized as unknown and foreign, heritage as a product); preservation – conservation and museum activities;
- "Own" and "foreign" artistic environment; the artist from the borderland and contemporary forms of disseminating art on the borderland; artistic movement of national minorities, forms of cultivating their own culture; borderland in cultural policy (state and local);
- Education issues of national minorities on the border;
- Educational dimension of migration;
- Economic migration (cross-border);
- National minorities on the border: sense of own identity and its relationship to the identity of another national group;
- Ways of defining the identity of a group, community, individual in relation to "the foreign" and "one's own" - conflicts or tolerance;
- Socio-demographic dilemmas: fertility, aging population, proportions of socio-professional groups, borderland population in age groups, social welfare, education level, rural-urban migration, issues of exclusion of people in terms of material status, health status (disability), gender; the state of health and medical care in the borderlands (in relation to the central areas);
- Economic policy issues in border regions - economic dimension of cross-border relations;

- Opportunities and barriers to the development of entrepreneurship in border areas; disproportions in the state of (technical) infrastructure - borderlands and other areas;
- Development strategies of regions and subregions;
- The value and protection of the natural and cultural landscape in the process of economic modernization of the borderland; natural resources and their protection or degradation under the slogan of economic and technical development and progress;
- Forest management - economic and exploitation aspect, and natural forest resources as a general social value;
- Armed conflicts on the border;
- Internal security on the border;
- Political orientations of the population on the border; support for individual parties (electorates), durability and dynamics of changes, trust in politicians; the state as "one's own" (mine) or distance?; other areas of political awareness.
